# **Frequently Asked Questions**

### Q What are the monthly meetings about?

A TWAW meetings are more than just range time – they provide a comprehensive program that includes certified instructors, training, practice time, interactive discussion, guest speakers. Helping Educate, Equip, and Empower women shooters at every level of shooting skill, selecting a hand gun and learning to care and clean your gun.

### Q May I attend a meeting before deciding to join?

A Yes, guest may attend <u>one time for free</u> at the 2pm Introduction and may stay for the 3pm educational topic meeting. 4pm Range practice is for TWAW members only. **Please RSVP.** 



Q How do I become a member? A It's easy on line go to <a href="www.thewellarmedwoman.com">www.thewellarmedwoman.com</a> Click on find a chapter, chose a state, scroll down until you fin Prescott. Or ask the a chapter leader for a mail in application.

# Q What does my membership cover? A The \$50 annual membership is broken into four areas:

- \* Members receive a TWAW hat, Gun Basics DVD, and membership card.
- \* 30% of each chapter's membership dues is put into a chapter fund for reimbursement to leaders to help offset the cost of organizing, marketing, and running your chapter they are all volunteers.
- \* Money is set aside for scholarships for women in need to help cover the cost of membership.
- \* The balance is used to provide administrative support, and marketing for the organization.

# **Q** Who can join TWAW Shooting Chapters?

A Any woman age 21 or older who is legally eligible to own a firearm can join TWAW.

#### Q What if I move to another city, or I'm traveling and want to attend another chapter meeting?

- A Your membership in TWAW is recognized at all of our chapters, subject to space availability. It is also transferrable should you decide to join a different chapter. Please contact the local TWAW leader for information and to RSVP.
- **Q** Who leads the meetings? A Our TWAW leaders are women with a passion for providing a safe environment for those who want to learn to shoot in the company of other women. They will organize and lead the meetings, and work together with their partner ranges to ensure you have certified instructors available to assist shooters with all levels of experience.
- **Q What about safety?** A Safety is the primary focus of TWAW Shooting Chapters Program. The 4 universal gun safety rules are taught, applied, and adhered to at all times.
- Q Can I learn to shoot by attending a TWAW meeting? A TWAW Prescott does not replace formal training but are here to help you practice your training. If you are brand new to shooting we want you to have the best possible start in becoming a safe and responsible firearms owner. We can recommend a numbers of local basic hand gun courses.

#### Q Are there any requirements for shooting with TWAW Prescott, once I become a member?

A <u>Yes, Each New Member must attend a 2 PM TWAW Introduction and Orientation</u> 1. Watch the Range Safety Video. 2. Know and understand and the 4 Universal Gun Safety Rules. 3. Know and understand the basic anatomy of your

handgun. Pass a basic Range Safety Check which will cover your ability to safely grip, load and unload your handgun, shoot your target.

**Q What do I need to wear to the range?** A Ball style hat, eye protection, ear protection. No low cut shirts or open toed shoes, HOT BRASS BURNS and may make you unsafe while handling your firearm.

Q Is there an additional fee to use the range? A. Yes, it is currently \$15 to TWAW members, who are not members of the Prescott Gun Club. If you are a member of PGC check with them to see if Sundays your covers are covered in your membership.

### Q Do I need to own a firearm to join?

A No - you do not need to own a firearm or have a conceal carry permit\* in order to attend the meetings. Many women take advantage of the available gun rental opportunities of our host ranges. and in some circumstances, try the wide variety of firearms our members bring to the meetings before making a decision to purchase their first gun. \*Unless required by your state for gun ownership.


